In collaboration with the **NUS Sustainable and Green Finance Institute**, this programme is designed for MSc in Sustainable and Green Finance students, offering Capstone projects, weekly industry talks, and access to a dedicated research institute. These opportunities equip students with current knowledge and hands-on industry exposure, preparing them for success in sustainable finance.

CAPSTONE PROJECT

Over a six-month period, students will have the opportunity to collaborate with **leading organisations** to tackle real-world challenges in sustainable finance. Examples of organisations that students have partnered with in the past include GIC, KPMG, SGX, and WWF. With support from **dedicated faculty and industry professionals**, students conduct in-depth research, craft strategic solutions, and deliver impactful results that prepare them for leadership in the evolving financial sector.

Powered by research and corporate partnerships, the NUS Sustainable and Green Finance Institute's **Weekly Industry Talk Series** features top sustainability leaders from banking, consulting, investment, and advocacy. These expert-led sessions offer MSc students **real-world insights and valuable networking opportunities**, shaping future leaders in sustainable finance.

THE NUS MSc IN SUSTAINABLE AND GREEN FINANCE (PART-TIME)

Designed for working professionals, this **part-time 21-month programme** empowers you to drive sustainable change within your organisation and beyond, while balancing work and study. The programme is designed to train students to challenge sustainability issues faced by businesses, financial institutions and investors in Asia and beyond.

It includes a **Practicum** which allows students to apply the concepts and frameworks learnt from the core and elective courses on the topics of sustainable and green finance in a real world situation or environment.
